'Insurer can't refuse claim citing existing condition'

SC: Proposer Has To Disclose Facts Within Knowledge

New Delhi: An insurer cannot repudiate a claim by citing an existing medical condition that was disclosed by the insured in the proposal form, once the policy has been issued, the Supreme Court has said.

A bench of justices D Y Chandrachud and BV Narasimha has said a proposer is under a duty to disclose to the insurer all material facts within his knowledge.

The proposer is presumed to know all the facts and circumstances concerning the

proposed insurance, it added.

While the proposer can only disclose what is known to him, the proposer's duty of disclosure is not confined to his actual knowledge, it also extends to those material facts which, in the ordinary course of business, he ought to know, the court said.

"Once the policy has been issued after assessing the medical condition of the insured, the insurer cannot repudiate the claim by citing an existing medical condition, which was disclosed by the insured in the proposal form and which condition has led to a particular risk in respect of which the claim has been made by the insured," the bench said in a re-

cent judgment. The top court

was hearing an appeal filed by Mamohan Nanda against the order of the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (NCDC), rejecting his plea seeking a claim for medical expenses incurred in the United States. Nanda had bought an Overseas Medical Insurance and Holiday Policy as he intended to travel to the US. On reaching the San Francisco airport, he suffered a heart attack and was admitted to a hospital, where angioplasty was performed on him and three stents were inserted to remove the blockage from the heart vessels. Subsequently, the appellant claimed the treatment expenses from the insurer, which was repudiated by the latter.

Minor girls kill 70-yr-old man

Kozhikode: Police have detained two minor girls charged of hacking a 70-year-old man to death after he reportedly tried to sexually assault his mother at Ayirankolly under Ambalavayal police station limits in Wayanad on Tuesday. The girls' mother has also been arrested under IPC section 302 for the murder of the man who is her relative. The girls and their mother surrendered before Ambalavayal police in the afternoon. They were staying in a shed near the house of the deceased. The body was found stuck in a sack and dumped in a 3-foot-deep pit in an adjacent plot.

Nashik: Seven unidentified people armed with iron rods and revolvers attacked the car in which Rohini Pranjali Khadse, daughter of NCP leader and former minister Eknath Khadse, was returning home to Jalgaon district on Monday night, police said on Tuesday.

At the time, the incident, Rohini and two others were in the vehicle. No one was injured, but the vehicle was damaged. A case of attempt to murder has been registered at the Jalgaon police station. "It was an attempt on my life and I am fearful that I remained unhurt," Rohini told TOI.

Jalgaon superintendent of police (SP) Pravin Munde confirmed the incident and said police teams were working to arrest the assailants. Inspector Rahul Khata of the Jalgaon police station said the assailants were on the run and efforts were on to trace and arrest them. A new round of shadow boxing seems to have begun in the first family of Tamil Nadu. What has set off the fresh bout of power tussle between DMK scion Udhayanidhi Stalin and his aunt M K Kanimozhi is the latest bid by the former to consolidate his position in the party. During his visit to Coimbatore on Sunday, he had enrolled scores of women into the DMK youth wing, who would have otherwise joined the party's women's wing which Kanimozhi heads.

Even as the membership drive was under way in Coimbatore, Kanimozhi issued a statement reiterating that women should be enrolled in the party's women's wing. The statement neither said women should enroll only in the women's wing nor did it insist that the youth wing should start roping in men alone.

"It is our duty to enroll women as the party's women's wing member and create opportunities for them," she said. DMK sources confirmed the induction of women in the youth wing did not go down well with Kanimozhi. However, DMK organisation secretary R S Bharathi said speculations of a rift between Kanimozhi and Udhayanidhi were baseless. This is not the first time the strains surfaced between Kanimozhi and Udhayanidhi.
